



Next steps for policy development in Montenegro

The objective of the discussion is to take stock of the results achieved so far in the area of policy development in Montenegro (including the drafting of strategies and legislation, analysis of impacts and consultation process), to discuss priorities for the next period and how to achieve them. The timing of the webinar coincides with the publication of the most recent SIGMA monitoring assessment and the finalisation of the PAR Strategy for 2022-2026 that contains a dedicated pillar on policy development. This provides a good opportunity to discuss state of play as well as the next steps for policy development process. The invited participants include the officials of the General Secretariat, the Ministry of Finance and Social Welfare, the Ministry of Public Administration, Digital Society and Media, the Secretariat for Legislation, the representatives of the Parliament as well as representatives of the Delegation of the EU in Montenegro and SIGMA experts.
